Thursday 5th October is census day for all schools, and the amount of funding the school receives to provide free infant meals throughout the year is based on the number of KS1 children eating lunch on this day. Therefore, **please encourage your child to have school lunch on Thursday**, even if they usually bring a packed lunch. We have tried to make the menu appealing for everyone!

Rule 238 of the Highway Code states:

"You **MUST NOT** wait or park on yellow lines during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates (or zone entry signs if in a Controlled Parking Zone) – see <u>'Traffic signs'</u> and <u>'Road markings'</u>. Double yellow lines indicate a prohibition of waiting at any time even if there are no upright signs. You **MUST NOT** wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings (see 'Road markings') when upright signs indicate a prohibition of stopping"

The Winchester City Council Parking Enforcement team will be giving illegal parking outside school a high priority over the coming weeks & months and visiting at pick up and drop off times. Drivers parking illegally are at risk of being issued with a fine which is currently £70.
