The advertisement for our new Headteacher was published online just before half term. Since then governors have hosted visits to the school from people who might be interested in applying for the post. We expect to be reviewing those applications in early March, and then deciding which of the applicants to take forward for interview. We are aware that change can be unsettling, and would like to reassure children, parents and our staff, that making sure that we get the right person is our key focus and we are being supported by colleagues at Hampshire County Council. Governors also said farewell to one of our longstanding co-opted governors, Martin Goff, this month. Martin has been a governor here for 17 years and his children all attended Kings Worthy. He was on the Governing Body that appointed Mrs Mullane to be our Headteacher back in 2011. His contribution has been significant, and he will be much-missed.

School Travel Plan

We have been working hard on our School Travel Plan and have successfully completed the last part of the Modeshift STARS accreditation scheme. We have successfully achieved the Bronze Award and Ellie Bolton from the HCC Strategic Travel Plan Team is visiting on Monday 19th March to present the award. It will be a normal school uniform day, however the children are invited to wear a bright accessory to be seen while walking to school; eg a hat/gloves/glasses in a bright or fluorescent colour. They could also decorate their scooter or bike/helmet.





Golden Mile

Great news on the Golden Mile! Recently, Kings Worthy Primary School were awarded the Golden Mile's School of the Year. Nominated schools were invited to attend the Winchester District Sports Awards ceremony and we were delighted to be rewarded with first place. Simon Harmer, a war veteran and guest speaker at the event presented the award to Poppy B and Andrew B. The judges commended us for completing over 16,000 miles in just two terms and for using the initiative to organise events such as 'Run with Mum'. To our surprise, Simon also added that he had once been a pupil at Kings Worthy and had many fond memories.

Huge congratulations go to the staff and children of Kings Worthy Primary School. It is only with their support and competitive spirit that we have been able to make this initiative a success. Last year we walked, jogged or ran a total of 18,500 miles and this year we have completed 11,000 miles since September. Many children have already achieved their 25 and 50 mile certificates. Absence Procedure

We have recently reviewed and formalised our telephone procedure in the mornings, when a child is absent from school and no notification has been received. We will telephone all contact numbers for that child, in the order notified by the parent, until we make contact with someone and obtain an explanation for the child's absence. If the contact does not pick up, a voicemail message will be left where possible. If by 10am we have not managed to speak to any of the contacts provided, the Senior Leadership Team will make a decision about further action. This will range from making a record but no further action, to making a home visit to contacting the Police. It is therefore very important that you contact the school office and leave a message on each day of your child's absence from school. Thank you.
