Children wearing smart school uniform is also something that is often commented upon by visitors and does reinforce the high expectations we have of children when they are in school. It would be helpful if you would ensure that your child's bag is **no bigger than 400mm wide and 300mm deep (small backpack size)** so that it easily fits into the units.
