Dear Parents,

At the end of school on Thursday your child will receive a free *Real Advent Calendar (FairTrade)* to take home as a gift from St Mary's Church.

Over many years, St Mary's promoted and sold *FairTrade* goods but in recent times these have become mainstream, so much so that we didn't need to continue selling them. It left us with a fund of money that we have been thinking how best to use. We've decided to re-invest that fund back into the *FairTrade* system by buying every child a Real Advent Calendar. On Thursday we'll be talking about Advent and preparing for Christmas, not just on the outside, but more importantly on the inside as we reflect on the Christmas message of joy and peace for all.

Every child who wishes to receive an Advent calendar will be given one. The ingredients are listed on the back includes the standard wording *'may also contain nuts'*. **Please ensure that this is suitable for your child before opening.**

In addition, on Thursday we will start a South American tradition of Posada ('journey') where figures of Mary and Joseph and the donkey will travel between classes as we remember the special journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem on that first Christmas. At the end of term, I will collect Mary & Joseph (and their travel journal/blog) and they will then travel around homes in the community before arriving at our Posada Crib Service on Sunday 24th December at 3.30pm at St Mary's.
