Year 6 Residential Trip 2019

Dear Parents & Carers,

We would like to thank those of you who attended the Osmington Bay meeting and we hope that many of your questions regarding the trip were answered. We are pleased to have confirmed the booking with PGL at Osmington Bay for next year's year 6 children for the week: **Monday 1st July – Friday 5th July 2019.**

The children will have the opportunity to take part in activities such as: Abseiling, Climbing, Fencing, Zip Wiring, Archery, Orienteering, Dragon-Boat racing and many other adventurous activities. Children taking part in the trip develop a number of important skills e.g. independence, self-motivation, communication, collaboration and taking personal responsibility. The food and accommodation are of a high standard and Osmington Bay offers top class activities with an impeccable level of safety.

The cost of this visit will be £452 per child, inclusive of insurance. This covers the cost of: activities (£233), travel (£30) and meals and lodgings (£189).

If you would like your child to take part in this multi-activity week, please complete the attached slip and return this to school with your **non-returnable** deposit of £57 by Friday 28th September 2018. In accordance with the school Charging policy, to ensure that the school can meet the financial commitment of this trip and to simplify the administration, please provide payment of the deposit plus five post-dated cheques payable to Kings Worthy Primary School, or a whole payment of £452. Alternatively, you may pay in monthly instalments between September and April –please see below, or via the Tucasi on-line system. However we do ask that your child's trip is paid for **in full by the end of April**, as this is when we have to settle the final invoice.

Please write the name of your child on the back of each cheque. Cheques will not be presented until their due date. Full payment must be made to the school by **Friday 26th April 2019** to enable us to pay PGL's final invoice. Places will unfortunately have to be cancelled for pupils for whom full payment has not been received, and any money will be refunded minus the £57 deposit and interim payment of £61. **Please also note that we are unable to secure any child a place on the trip if their deposit has not been paid.**

You will receive more detailed information regarding the trip nearer the time.

If you would prefer to pay the initial deposit of £57 followed by 1 monthly instalment of £61 in October and then 5 monthly instalments of £56, (November 2018 - March 2019) and one of £54 (April 2019) you may do so. Please provide post-dated cheques as this significantly reduces the amount of admin time and cost to the school. Alternatively, if you prefer to pay online using Scopay, please do so (either in full or in instalments using one of the two schemes above.) No further reminders will be sent and trips not paid for in full by April 26th risk losing their deposits and interim payments.

The attendance of children on the visit is viewed as an additional opportunity, and there is no requirement for children to take part. Supervision arrangements are in place in school for any children who do not go to Osmington Bay. If a child is excluded from school in year 6 for unsatisfactory behaviour, their place on the visit will be reconsidered and may be withdrawn.
