### Entering School Reminder

This is primarily down to health and safety and safeguarding issues as we would have no record of who is in the building if there was a fire alarm or emergency.

Also, in order to manage limited space and priorities appropriately, parents/carers should not enter classrooms with their children at the start, or any part of the day. Parents of children in Year R are the only exception to this rule first thing in the morning during the autumn term. If children arrive after the gates are closed please ensure that children then enter through the main door and walk to class independently.
