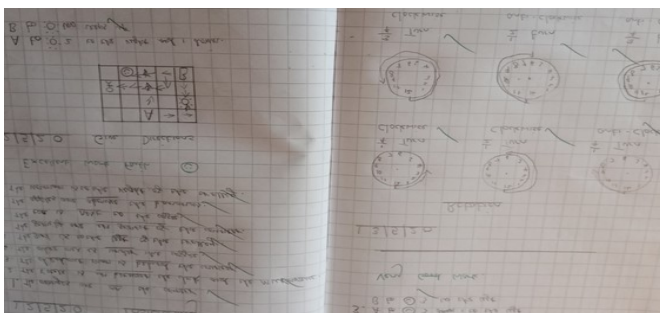

Dear Parents and Carers,

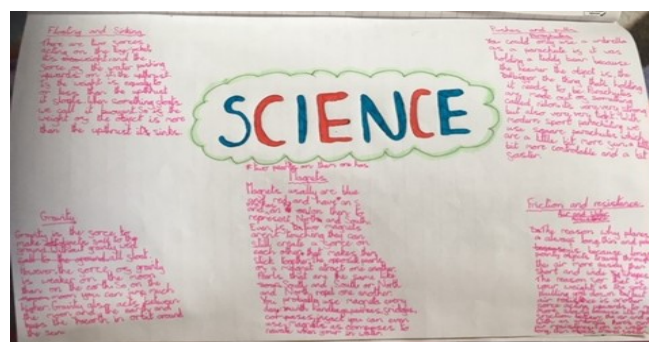
Summer Term Continues
