Anti-Bullying Week

Across the school this week all year groups have been learning about anti-bullying. On Monday we all wore our 'odd socks' to show our support for anti-bullying week. There were bright colours, stripes, spots and all kinds of crazy combinations. This year's theme was, 'united against bullying' and this was discussed in assemblies and lessons throughout the week. Year 1 enjoyed watching the 'Odd Socks Day' assembly that was performed by Andy (from 'Andy's dinosaur adventures') on YouTube and then learning more about why we shouldn't bully in school during their weekly Thrive lesson.

Year 4

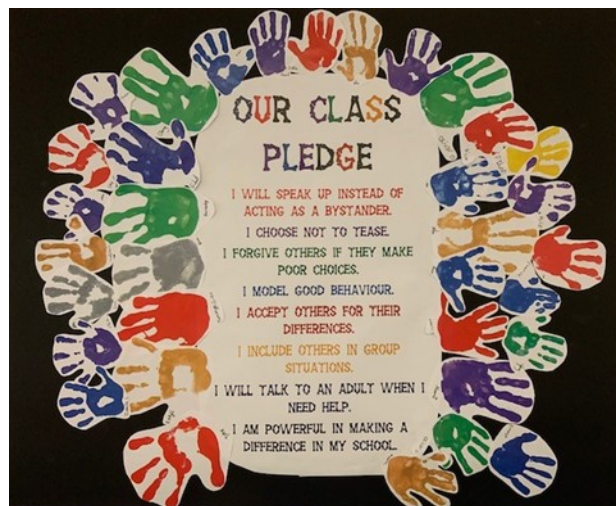

"If we work together we can stop bullying completely." *(Oliver Year 4)*

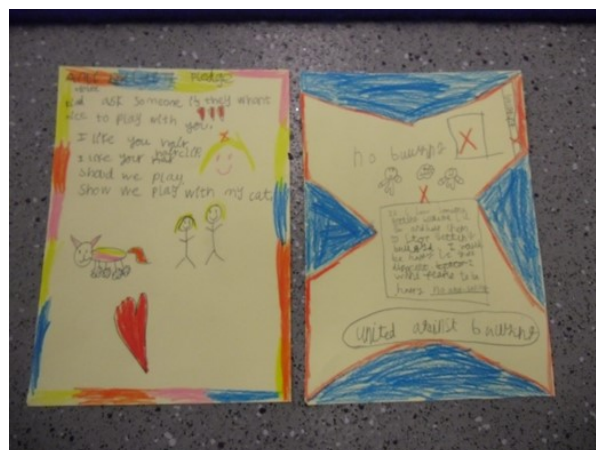
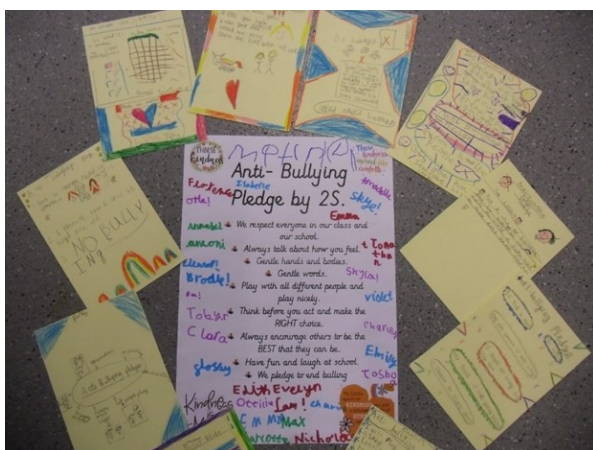


Year 3

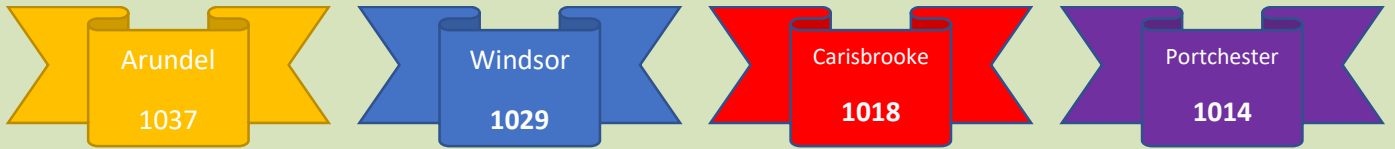
Library Update

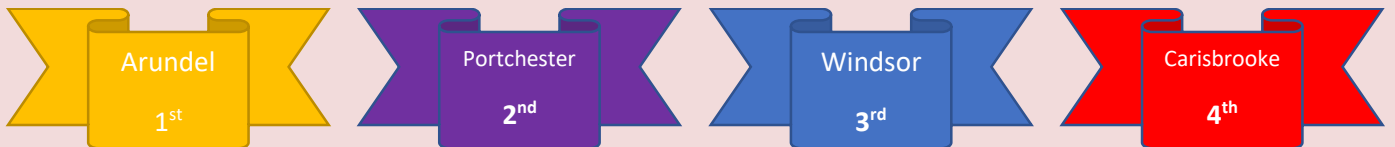
School photos
