We would like to wish a warm welcome to Mrs Mitchell who joined our Year R team this week. She will be working in Rabbits class five days a week and across our Year R unit.

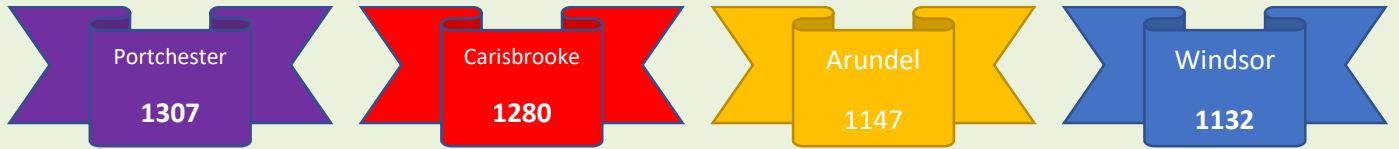

### School Lunches

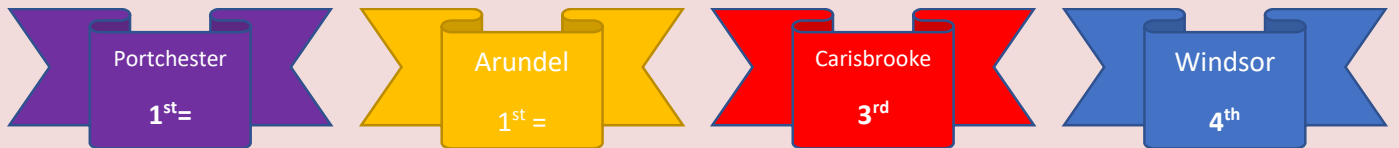
