Dear Parents and Carers,

### **Have a holly, jolly Christmas!**

Perhaps the miracle of Christmas has befallen all of the children at Kings Worthy this year, as we are yet to have a positive Covid case in school. There are not many primary schools in Hampshire that can lay claim to this feat. Simply amazing!

Should one of your children who attend receive a positive test over the Christmas break, please could you email the school on [adminoffice@kingsworthy.hants.sch.uk](mailto:adminoffice@kingsworthy.hants.sch.uk) to let us know the name of the child, their class and the date that he or she first displayed symptoms of Covid. We will monitor this email account throughout the holiday as we are required to report any cases to the DfE, and this will help us to ensure that we offer the correct advice deemed by Public Health England to be at risk through contact with the child in school. The biggest risk is through contact up to December 23<sup>rd</sup> but please let us know anyway.

You **do not** need to contact us regarding any other family member with a positive test outcome – only children from the school.

Please note that the self-isolation period for adults and children in contact with a person who has had a positive test outcome is now 10 days, and not 14. This applies with immediate effect, including anyone who is in the middle of a self-isolation period. Should your child be unable to return to school on January 4<sup>th</sup> due to self-isolating, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can organise home learning.

As it is now unlikely that I will receive any further guidance about changes to school procedures and safety until the beginning of January, I have made the decision to keep our staggered drop-off and pick-up times as they are for the first week back. If there are any significant changes that I am informed about during the Christmas period I will of course let you know through the school email system.

Lastly, I would like to wish each and every one of you a wonderful Christmas. For many of us, it is a year that we will be happy to leave behind us in so many ways. I would like to thank my fabulous team for pulling together so well these last few months, in dare I say, the phrase of the year, 'unprecedented times'. To you, the parents, for your unwavering support throughout the most difficult period of time any family has had to go through. And special mention, of course, to all of the children who have been world class since returning to school in September and working so hard every day. We will continue to do our very best for you and them in 2021.

Don't forget the Strictly final tomorrow – Hrvy (!) & Manrarararara to win!

### Year 3 - Winchester Cathedral

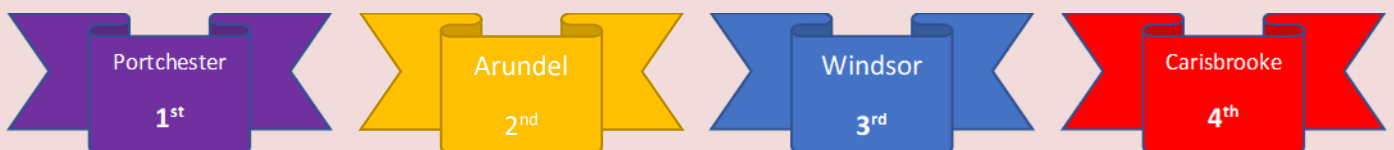
