

Dear Parents and Carers,

Google Classroom

I am delighted to be able to tell you that the first stage of our new online learning platform, 'Google Classroom', is complete. Miss Keeble, Mrs Morgan, Mrs Moore and myself completed our training yesterday evening and we are looking forward to imparting our knowledge to the rest of the staff team on Monday.

This virtual classroom is being set-up for children who may be well, but needing to self- isolate. From early next week, the children in year groups from 2-6 will be coming home with details about how to log-in to Google classroom. After that, class teachers will be setting homework tasks on Google classroom so that the children are able to get used to this exciting new technology. Once these initial tasks are completed by the children they can then upload their finished homework to their virtual classroom page. Teachers will then be able to respond to the uploaded tasks either virtually and/or in class teaching time. It is important to remember that as all of our staff are involved in 'live' teaching in school across each day, responding to online learning may involve a brief time delay.

I hope that you will understand that we will do our best to support children needing to spend time at home in continuing to learn, but it is important to remember that all of our teachers are teaching full classes in school and I would like to thank you for your support regarding attendance. Therefore, the availability of our adults to teach remotely alongside this is limited. If a year group or a significant number of children are self-isolating then we will adapt our plans accordingly to support this.

It is also important to remember that when children are at home ill, we do not usually provide home learning for them. We feel that your child will need to rest and recuperate so that they are ready to return to school feeling well and ready to learn back in school. So, if your child is ill, rather than self-isolating, we will not be setting virtual work online for them to complete.

Year R and Year 1 will continue to use Tapestry for home learning should it be required. I will of course provide further 'Google classroom' updates in upcoming newsletters.

'I loved it and if you get to see Jungle Jonathon you will love it!' (Ethan, 3A)











Parking
