Dear Parents and Carers,

School bus incident

I am sure you are all aware of the school bus incident yesterday morning. Henry Beaufort were quick to inform me that there were, luckily, no serious injuries with only a few children taken to hospital as a precautionary measure. Some of our year 6 children from last year who were on the bus came and spoke to Miss Eggleston yesterday afternoon to give her their accounts of what happened and were in good spirits. Our thoughts go out to any of our families who were affected by the incident. If you feel it necessary, do not hesitate to contact the school if you would like us to support your child if they had siblings on the bus.

PE days and clothing

Thank you all for supporting your children to be ready for PE this week and coming into school dressed ready. They should now have their trainers/plimsolls in school and can change into them when needed. On PE days the children should wear their school PE t-shirt in house colours (Arundel - yellow, Carisbrooke - red, Portchester - purple, Windsor - blue) and white/navy or black shorts. On colder days, children can wear long navy or black leggings or tracksuit trousers. Please can you avoid sending the children into school in football shirts. Below are the days when each class has PE and should therefore come to school in their PE kit.

1H and 1W – Tuesday and Thursday

2S and 2W - Monday and Friday

3M - Wednesday and Friday

3A – Thursday and Friday

4B and 4S – Tuesday and Wednesday

5A and 5R – Tuesday and Thursday

6C - Tuesday and Friday

6K – Tuesday and Wednesday

Children in Rabbits and Hedgehogs will receive further information about PE when they have settled into school.

Hedgehogs and Rabbits

The new children arrived in Hedgehogs and Rabbits this week. They have settled in brilliantly and they are already establishing themselves incredibly well within the school.

Pupil Premium

Please can I urge those families who may be entitled to free school meals to register their entitlement (please check on www.hants.gov.uk; 'education and learning', 'school meals', 'Free School Meals for pupils up to 16 years old') even if your child is in Key Stage 1 and entitled to free school meals as a matter of course. Additional funding, to be spent in aspects of provision for your child, is given to every school, based on the known free school meal figures. The funding is called Pupil Premium. More detail about the Pupil Premium will be sent out next week.

Bikes and Scooters

Children (and adults!) should not ride cycles or scooters in the school grounds at the start or end of the day, to ensure the safety of all people on the playground. This includes pre-school children who may have a bike or scooter. Bikes/scooters should be left in the appropriate bike sheds.

Applying for a secondary school place for September 2020

Children in Year 6 will receive information from Hampshire County Council about September 2020 admissions. If your child is currently in year 6 the applications open on **14**th **September**. You have 47 days to apply from this date – the national application deadline is **31**st **October 2020**. Our 2 Female ducks are obviously very happy in their new home as they are now laying Eggs every day.


