More Covid updates

As the lockdown has ended this week, here are a few reminders about coming onto and leaving the school site:

- If possible, one adult on drop-off and collection only
- Please maintain the one-way system, unless you have spoken to the office about reasons not to
- Please continue to wear a face covering when on the school site this is mandatory under the updated guidance (unless you have a medical condition that prevents you from doing so)
- Do not allow your children to cycle or scooter when on site
- Leave the school site as promptly as possible
- Try to avoid conversations with teachers at classroom doors as entrances need to be clear so that the teachers can co-ordinate hand sanitising. If you would like to discuss anything with the teachers please phone or email




Elin C in Year 5 also received a commendation.
