The Green Cross Code

THINK – Is it a safe place to cross? Could I use a crossing?

<u>STOP</u> — Stand a little back from the kerb away from traffic.

LOOK – Look right then left then right again

<u>LISTEN</u> — Listen carefully! Sometimes you can hear the traffic before seeing it

<u>CROSS</u> — When it's clear, cross the road. Keep looking & DO NOT RUN

Did You Know?

Nearly 2500 children under the age of 16 are injured or killed on our roads in the UK each year!

Children will copy adults when it comes to road safety. Therefore, a good example must be set!

Reflective clothing can be seen 3 times as far away as non reflective clothing



BE BRIGHT TIPS

Wear fluorescent clothing daytime & reflective at night

Keep to footpaths where possible

Be aware of your surroundings. Take out earphones & put mobiles away

Check lights work when cycling. It is the law to have white front lights & red rear lights as well as reflectors

Now it is darker earlier it is important to be seen when by the roads. How can I be bright?

Bike reflectors Zip clips stickers hi vis clothes snap bands
















Which image do you think would help vehicles see you?
