Reading	 Read for at least twenty minutes each day. Choose an activity each day from the reading rainbow activities.
Spelling	 On the website is the Year 3/4 spelling list. Pick 10 spellings that you find tricky and practise them in 3 different ways (this could be 'look, write, cover, check', 'rainbow writing', 'pyramid spell', creating mnemonics, or your own creative way!). If this spelling list is a bit too tricky, try finding some words on the 'High Frequency Word List'. Once you have practised your spellings, make sure you know what each of them mean and use them in a sentence! Try to challenge yourself to write a sentence that has all 10 of your spellings in!
Writing	 Grammar skills - The main focus for this week is to work on grammar skills. Complete some BBC bitesize tasks. See the link: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/tags/zmyxxyc/year-3-lessons/1 Lessons to try - Identifying verbs, adjectives, pronouns and nouns lessons. Writing Task - Can you write a 50 word story? I know this is tricky, but I'll add a few examples to show you. Choose what you would like to write about and remember to send them in.
Maths	 Mental Maths – Practise times tables and number bonds. Suggested resources include: Hit the Button and Loop cards on <u>www.topmarks.co.uk</u> and <u>https://ttrockstars.com/</u> Fractions - Follow this link to the White Rose Home Learning page <u>https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-3/</u>. This week, complete Summer Week 2 lessons 1-4 and the Friday challenge. For each lesson, you can watch the video before completing the worksheets. If you can't print the worksheet, you could draw out the questions into your book/ onto paper, or just write the answers if you want to. Use the answer sheet on the White Rose Home Learning website to mark your answers and correct any questions where you may have made an error.
