Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read for at least twenty minutes each day. • Choose an activity each day from the reading rainbow activities.
Spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the website is the Year 3/4 spelling list. Pick 10 spellings that you find tricky and practise them in 3 different ways (this could be 'look, write, cover, check', 'rainbow writing', 'pyramid spell', creating mnemonics, or your own creative way!). If this spelling list is a bit too tricky, try finding some words on the 'High Frequency Word List'. • Once you have practised your spellings, make sure you know what each of them mean and use them in a sentence! Try to challenge yourself to write a sentence that has all 10 of your spellings in!
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board Game - Create a board game related to the boat, river or sea work. See the attached game board proformas for ideas. Focus on writing questions and answers. • Instructions part 1 - Write a set of instructions for how the game should be played. Focus on using imperative verbs such as take, turn, spin. Ask a parent to read the instructions and offer feedback in order to improve them. • Instructions part 2 – Write another set of instructions. Choose something different like Make a cake, Create a Lego model or How to be kind to your brother/sister. See the attached examples.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mental Maths – Practise times tables and number bonds. Suggested resources include: Hit the Button and Loop cards on www.topmarks.co.uk and https://trockstars.com/ • Fractions - Follow this link to the White Rose Home Learning page https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-3/ . This week, complete Summer Week 1 lessons 1-5. For each lesson, you can watch the video before completing the worksheets. If you can't print the worksheet, you could draw out the questions into your book/ onto paper, or just write the answers if you want to. Use the answer sheet on the White Rose Home Learning website to mark your answers and correct any questions where you may have made an error. • Geometry - Complete the MyMaths tasks.
