Itinerary for Friday 6th March

8.45am – Arrive at school as normal

Children will need to wear full school uniform. Depending on the weather on the day, a coat is optional as the Studios are inside and it is quite warm.

9.15 - Watch Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.

We have decided that seeing as the Harry Potter studios features the sets from the films, as well as all of the costumes and props that it would be beneficial for the children to watch the film before we visit.
