


Salut, Year 5! Ça va?

- Write a different day of the week on each part and the English on the back.
 Be creative, so that you will want to use them for revision.
- Test yourself on translating both ways and when you have done this, practise the spellings. Use playdoh, sand, squirty cream(!), etc, if you have them to make this more fun.
- Can you teach them to someone else?
- Ask someone to test you. Can you say, recognise and spell them in any order? Can you give the one before / the one after?
- Create a poster of the days of the weeks. Illustrate what you might do on each day of the week (the day to be written in French). You don't need to be truthful! No English! No capital letters!
