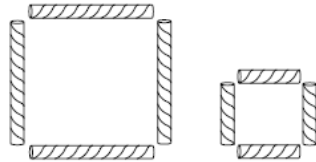
- Spend at least fifteen minutes a day on Times Tables Rockstars.
