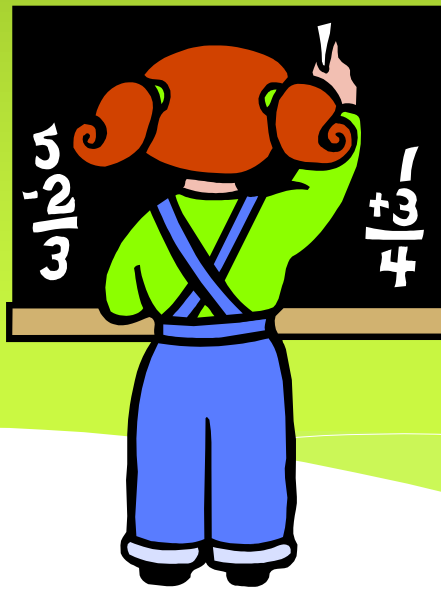

# Transition from Year R

- \* We are working really hard to make sure the children move smoothly from Year R to 1.
- \* We have lots of different continuous provision areas including a role play area, construction and small world play equipment all of which will be used frequently to support the children's learning.

# Reading

- \* **Reading:** In Year 1 we no longer have specific 'book change' days. Children are given the opportunity to independently change their books every day in school. They will be reading in school, but the children really do benefit greatly from reading at home with you as well. We ask that you read for 10 minutes every day, even if it is just a few pages.

# Reading and Reading Diaries

- \* When you hear your child read, please ensure you note this in their reading diaries. We check the diaries once a week, so please make us aware in the morning if there's something urgent.
- \* Library exchange – We will have time to change library books on a Tuesday.



# Other important information

- \* Nut allergies:

- \* Please do not send your child to school with any form of nuts in their lunchbox (e.g. peanut butter or Nutella)

- \* Healthy School:

- \* No sweets please!
- \* We prefer children not to bring sweets or cakes for their birthdays as we cannot hand them out during school time.
