
Octopus

There are over 300 different species of octopus and they are usually found in tropical oceans or around coral reefs. They can squeeze into tight spaces as they do not have a skeleton and can camouflage to protect themselves from predators. Often their diet consists of small crabs, snails, fish, turtles and shrimp which they catch using their long tentacles and then use their hard beak to poison and paralyse their prey.
