School Uniform

Could I ask for your support in ensuring that your child comes to school each day appropriately dressed in school uniform. It is our belief that uniform produces a sense of corporate belonging, pride in oneself and the school, enables consistent standards to be maintained by all children and reduces the impact of fashion and designer-wear to a minimum, particularly for those children who do not have access to such clothes. Could I please make a strong plea that all children wear sensible, black shoes that are suitable for school. Strapless shoes or sandals are not appropriate and I would ask for your support over this. For PE, could I ask that you stick to the normal house coloured PE shirts and black, blue or white shorts. As the weather continues to improve the children shouldn't need to wear their tracksuit bottoms.

Jewellery/Make-up

It is our expectation that children do not wear jewellery of any kind (except a single stud earring), make up or nail varnish to school. Clearly this is for all the reasons identified above. Thank you for your support in ensuring that your children do not wear make-up, nail varnish or jewellery to school.

Hairstyles

Styles should be modest; grade one or two cuts, tramlines and Mohican-style cuts, unnatural colours etc. are not allowed. If there is any uncertainty, please contact the school office. As the summer holidays approach, I would ask that experimenting with hairstyles and colours be kept to this time.

Mrs Hall


