We are very excited to announce that we have secured a booking for Year 5 to visit the Harry Potter Studio Tour on Thursday 24th March 2022. This experience will include a full studio tour of 'The Making of Harry Potter' with the sets, costumes, visual effects and props, as well as a hands-on workshop exploring the making of the films.

The itinerary of the day will run over usual school hours to allow us enough time to explore the entire wizarding world of Harry Potter! Our planned schedule is below:

8:45 – Children should arrive at school at the usual time

9:30 – Leave Kings Worthy

11:30-17:00 – Workshop, studio tour and shop visit

17:00 – Depart Harry Potter Studios

18:30 – Arrive back at Kings Worthy for collection outside the school hall*

**Our arrival time back to Kings Worthy may change depending on traffic, we will update you via the scopay email communication system on the day of the trip.*

We will have time during the day to visit the 'Making of Harry Potter Shop'. If you have visited the tour before, you will be aware that the shop is extensive with many items for children to buy. We would recommend looking at the shop website prior to our visit so your child can choose whether they would like to buy anything and, if so, what they would like to buy.
